Instructors can add a URL to their class to link to additional information, such as a departmental website or a class website. Students would see the URL in the Class Search results, giving them easy access to your class information.

Access

1. Log in to **MyU.umn.edu** with your Internet ID and password.
2. Click on the **Teaching** tab.
3. Click on the **Faculty Center** link at the bottom of the page.
4. Click on the **URL** link for the desired class.




